TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ENFORCEMENT PROTOCOL

Traffic Management and Enforcement at Ransomes Europark is necessary to maintain a safe environment for tenants and visitors to the estate

- Our objectives are to maintain a fee flow of traffic both inbound and outbound, all the estate roads are strictly No Waiting No Parking No Loading
- We are instructed to maintain a free flow of traffic at all times.
- Our objective is not to permit vehicles to park or wait on the estate roads.
- We are instructed to issue Notices of Trespass to any vehicle which contravenes the landowner's policy.
- Vehicles parking or waiting on any estate roads or obstructing pathways will immediately be subject to a Notice for trespass.
- Vehicles committing trespass are photographed and a Notice stating the time, registration and location will be either affixed to the vehicle or forwarded to the owner/driver/Keeper via post.
- Our operatives use video capture devices for crime and security prevention, and to monitor our enforcement Operations.
- Failure to pay any Notice will result in a fee paying enquiry to the DVLA to establish the owner/drivers/keeper details.
- All unpaid Notices will be pursued by a claim for trespass in the County Court.
- Any vehicles or trailers left unattended are subject to immediate removal.
- We are instructed to record and monitor the duration, length, source and destination of HGV queues on the estate.
- The land has a control by barrier policy , which could result in any vehicle being restricted from moving and leaving the land
- Forklift trucks and Reach Stackers are restricted from using the estate private roads on health and safety and road traffic regulation grounds, unless in exceptional circumstances and only when escorted.
- We operate in conjunction with the various authorities accompanied by Event Guard Security Officers operational at the estate.
